# Personal and Household Safety Equipment for West Marsh Residents

The following items can be provided free of charge to residents of West Marsh by referral or request (address required). Pictures are for illustration purposes. Actual items may differ. Subject to availability and project funding.

Personal alarms to carry with you.

1. Personal Alarm (slimline)



2. Personal Alarm (wrist worn)



<u>Plugin Timers.</u> Have a light come on at selected times to give the appearance that you're in when you're out.

<u>Battery powered alarms.</u> Hang over a door handle or stick to your window. If someone or something moves it then the alarm can alert you.

**6.** Over handle, motion detecting door handle alarm



7. Stick to window sensor alarm







<u>Torch.</u> Got a dark entrance way or out after dark? Carry a torch.

8. Small LED torch.





TV simulator. Gives the appearance that your TV is on when you are out. Needs to be behind a curtain so it can be seen from outside. Our TV simulator is mains powered/plugin, but we do have some battery powered ones too. If you have a preference let us know otherwise we'll provide whatever we have.

**Lights.** Illumination when it's dark.

## Specialist items.

**12.** Howsarlock security device useful for unlockable internal doors in shared accommodation for example



13. Patlock for use on suitable double handled patio doors. These are limited supply, expensive items so we'll need to assess that you have the right sort of double handed patio doors and have a need for this item. Please ask if you think this would be useful.



Out and about. Protect your possessions against theft when you are out and about.

**14.** Under arm, cross body, hidden pocket. Tuck you valuables out of the way under your clothing or coat.



**15.** 'Bag dipping kit'. Bells in your hand bag rattle if someone tries to grab it. Carabiner and hooks to secure items & a little mini alarm to keep in your bag.



<u>Hide your valuables at home.</u> Tuck some of your small valuables out of sight in these pretend cans and books on your shelf or in with your groceries. Reduce the chance of things being found.

**16. Safe cans and books.** Different types. Tell us which you would prefer.





Bike security. Through a special arrangement with HumberWatch we can provide these free bike locks. We need to collect your contact details and type of your bike too. If you've had a recent bike theft and have reported it with an incident number then please let us know this too as these are aimed at those who have been victims of bike theft.

Don't forget that NEL Council are running a bike lock swap scheme too with an even better lock for £10 if you swap in your old lock. Details on the NELC website news.

<u>Selecta DNA.</u> Police accredited invisible marking of your property. When marking your property you will need to ensure you register the items online too. If you would like one of these kits, please contact West Marsh Community Centre who have a small supply. They can also help with your registration process if needed.



Last chance for a <u>free security assessment of your house</u> and installation of additional security items not covered above. This is a referral process and your house must be in the West Marsh. Referrals need to be made before the end of March 2022 to take up this offer. Again, please contact West Marsh Community Centre direct to ask about this or refer yourself.

**Something else?** If there is a small item of home or personal security that is not listed here that you think you need then *please contact us to discuss*. We can't provide items that require installation (CCTV, security lights etc), but if you are in West Marsh and have a home security visit then it is possible you might be eligible for something like this.
